For organizational reasons, we invite you to pre-register free of charge by e-mail or post until Sunday, May 12, 2024. However, it will be possible to register on site (only on Saturday, from 10am to 12pm, for a fee of €2 per model. Meal trays are available on reservation only.



## **PREAMBLE**

Entry into the competition implies acceptance of all articles below as binding contest rules.

The competition tables are reserved solely for registered competition entries, which must be displayed in the competition

All other pieces (from model clubs or from individuals) will be displayed on the designated tables in adjacent rooms.

All subjects are judged according to the defined principles advised for each category, with a more stringent requirement for the « Master » categories. Subjects in the Master category will be judged to a more rigorous standard m and will be examined in more depth than in others and will be accompanied by a certificate of merit.

Medals are not awarded systematically in all categories.

A piece that has already won a medal or has already been presented at a previous Saumur competition will be disregarded

and not judged.

The «Général ESTIENNE» prize will be awarded to the « best of show » in the competition, the «Colonel AUBRY» prize will be awarded to the favourite subject of the President of the AAMBC (the organization in charge of the model contest), and the «Best Young Person» prize will be awarded to the best entry from the junior age group. The results will be rounded out by a number of other awards, including the «Coup de Coeur» prize decided by the vendors, model associations and clubs present.

## THE JURY

The jury is made up of model builders with recognized expertise in modeling and in history.

Jury members may not take part in the competition in any category. A display case showing their work will be available in the competition room.

Model building is first and foremost a hobby, driven by a passion for history and for model building techniques. Any expressions of dissatisfaction will result in subjects being excluded from the competition, as will their authors. The jury's decisions are final and irrevocable. The deliberations will take place behind closed doors to ensure the serenity of the judging.

During the judging, only the judges will be allowed in the room, except with the agreement of the chairman of the jury (press, organisation, etc.).

Art 1: The competition is open to all model builders who are independent, or affiliated to a club or organization.

Art 2: In order to be judged, each model must include at least one military vehicle or vehicle of military origin (wheels, tracks, semi-tracks on civilian or military chassis), whether or not it existed, such as prototypes or paper-panzers.

Art 3: Subjects will be deposited on Saturday from 08:00 to 14:00. They can only be collected after the results have been

announced on Sunday. Any earlier collection must be approved by the Chairman of the Jury.

Art 4: Each subject will be presented with an information sheet containing its name and number, the category and the number of its owner. No distinctive sign identifying a club or its author on the sheet or on the model will be tolerated. Should this rule not be observed, the model will be disqualified.

Art 5: Models are considered to be parts that have been assembled, glued and painted by the model builder. Commercial models that have already been assembled and painted will not be judged.

Art 6: If a piece is offensive, degrading, racist or otherwise likely to shock or offend public decency in the eyes of the audience, the organisers or the jury, it will be excluded from the competition.

Art 7: The jury reserves the right to delete a category if it does not include at least three entries from different modellers.

It will then be added to another similar category.

The same applies to pieces that do not correspond to the category in which they are registered.

Art 8 : Each participant can only claim one nomination per category. If a participant is registered in the « Master » category, all his other pieces must also be in the « Master » category.

Art 9: The same piece may not be registered in more than one category.

Art 10: Participants who have won a gold medal at a previous event must register for the « Master's » category. This category is of course open to all model builders.

The jury reserves the right to move Standard-level pieces to the « Master » category if it deems the level worthy of a master. **Art 11:** Scratch category

Model produced entirely from a plan and including a max. of 20% of commercially available parts. (as well as photoetched, 3D printed, cast resin and other parts)

A complete 3D-printed model does not meet the scratch category criteria.

Each model should be accompanied by a document explaining the assembly, together with photographs, so that the jury can better appreciate the stages of production and the extent of the work carried out. Paintwork will not be an essential award criterion.

Art 12: Single model category

Only entries comprising a single military vehicle on a base free of any decorative elements will be judged. Models with figurines in the hatches or placed on a basic terrain representation will be tolerated.

Art 13: Dioramas category

Creation of a living scene including one or several military land vehicles. All the elements making up the work will be taken into consideration, such as its history, composition, quality of execution, painting, presentation, etc.

Art 14: Photo category

Entries must represent a perfect reproduction translating a realistic scene taken from a photograph. This photo must be displayed next to the model. Entries that do not meet this criterion will not be judged.

**Art 15**: Junior category

Open only to participants under the age of 16 on 18 May 2024. An identity document must be presented at registration. However, juniors may enter all other categories. Art 16: Humour and Uchrony category

All land models of any scale resulting from the humorous imagination of their author, including Paper-Panzers, futuristic prototypes that may or may not have existed.

**Art 17:** Thematic Category

Entries are limited to one model per modeler. It must be consistent and correspond to the theme decided by the museum (« 1944, year of the landings »). The category is open to any modeler and will be judged using the Master's criteria.

## **REGISTRATION FREE EXHIBITIONS**

Each participant is free to set up his or her own tables, and the museum is committed to ensuring that quality prevails over quantity. A few rules must be observed:
